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HOUSE AMENDMENT " *B* " to H.P. 1594, L.D. 2180,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Require Supervisory Auditors to  
Obtain Professional Certification within 3 Years."

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Amend the Bill by striking out everything after  
the enacting clause and inserting in its place the  
following:

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Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §242, as amended by PL 1985, c.  
785, Pt. B, §12, is further amended by adding after  
the first paragraph 2 new paragraphs to read:

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Any person elected to the position of State  
Auditor and any person hired as a permanent employee  
by the Department of Audit as deputy auditor, director  
of audits, assistant director of audits or auditor  
III, after the effective date of this paragraph, must  
be qualified as a certified public accountant, public  
accountant or certified internal auditor by July 1,  
1991. Persons not so qualified after July 1, 1991,  
may be employed in these audit supervisory positions  
on a temporary basis not to exceed 9 months.

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Any person permanently employed in the position of  
deputy auditor, director of audits, assistant director  
of audits or auditor III, as of the effective date of  
this paragraph, shall be exempt from the provisions of  
this section. Following the effective date of this  
paragraph, any permanent employee hired to serve in

1 positions shall meet the requirements of this section.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

3 This amendment allows persons currently serving in  
4 the positions of deputy auditor, director of audits,  
5 assistant director of audits and auditors III to  
6 remain in these positions until they leave. New  
7 persons hired to fill these positions are required to  
8 meet the standards.
