SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1594, L.D. 2180,

8

Bill, "AN ACT to Require Supervisory Auditors to

9

Obtain Professional Certification within 3 Years."

Amend the bill by striking out everything after

11

the enacting clause and inserting in its place the

12

following:

'Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §242, as amended by PL 1985, c.

14

785, Pt. B, §12, is further amended by adding after

15

the first paragraph a new paragraph to read:

16

Any person hired as a permanent employee by the

17

Department of Audit as deputy auditor, director of

18

audits, assistant director of audits or auditor III,

19

after the effective date of this paragraph, must be

20

qualified as a certified public accountant, public

21

accountant or certified internal auditor, by July 1,

22

1991. Persons not so qualified after July 1, 1991,

23

may be employed in these audit supervisory positions

24

on a temporary basis not to exceed 9 months.

25

Sec. 2. Transition provision. Any audit

26

supervisory employee of the Department of Audit who

27

was permanently employed by the department as of the

28

effective date of this Act shall be exempt from the

29

requirements of section 1.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

2 This amendment places the effective date directly
3 into the section of allocated law instead of in an
4 unallocated section and amends the transition
5 provision so that any person who is already
6 permanently employed in an audit supervisory position
7 as of the effective date of this Act is not required
8 to meet these requirements.
