Resolve, to Develop a Plan to Minimize and Dispose of Household Hazardous Waste.

Development of household hazardous collection disposal. Resolved: That and the Department of Environmental Protection shall formulate a plan for minimizing the generation of household hazardous waste and developing economical environmentally sound methods of properly collecting,

Resolved: That the plan shall be completed by January 1, 1989, and shall be 21 22 submitted, together with any necessary implementing legislation, to the joint standing committee of the 23 Legislature having jurisdiction over natural resources 24 25 as part of the small quantity hazardous waste program plan required by Public Law 1987, chapter 491, section 26 27 27.
