amendment 5 reduces the amount appropriation for expanded shellfish monitoring by \$194,996 which is provided in the Part II budget. It adds a \$25 increase in the retail seafood license, thereby increasing license revenues by an additional \$53,425. Therefore, the net fiscal impact of this 6 7 8 9 10 11 bill after subtracting the appropriation authorized by 12 this bill from the revenue produced is an increase in 13 General Fund revenues of \$3,411.

This amendment also changes the method of apportioning fees to the General Fund and the Shellfish Fund for purposes of administrative efficiency. The change contained in this amendment is intended to produce the same total allocation as provided in the original bill.
