STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment replaces the proposed legislative increase to the Hospital Development Account. It establishes a procedure for the Department of Human Services to recommend an interim adjustment to the amount debited to the Hospital Development Account to allow projects of urgent need or compelling benefit to
