26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33	Enactment of this bill will require a General Fund appropriation of \$164,787 in fiscal year 1989 to fund Medicaid's share of the \$7,800,000 adjustment. It is estimated that the General Fund share of Medicaid will be \$342,139 in fiscal year 1990 and \$513,723 in fiscal year 1991. The \$7,800,000 adjustment could also impact the cost of the state health insurance premiums.'

1	STATEMENT OF FACT
2	This amendment does the following:
3 4	 Deletes the emergency preamble and emergency clause; and
5 6 7 8 9	2. Reduces the amount of the credit for deferred and new projects from \$10,000,000 to \$7,800,000. This amount is based upon the historical underfunding of the account for the past few years. This amendment will allow a substantial portion of the new and deferred projects now pending to be finally approved.
11 12 13 14 15 16	This amendment permits the Department of Human Services to apply new credits added to the Hospital Development Account for the statewide component and not to the individual hospital component. Any unused credits would be carried over to a subsequent year as provided by current law. There would still be an overall cap on approvable projects.
18 19 20 21	This amendment also requires the Department of Human Services to contract with a hospital based in northern Maine to conduct a hospital-based psychiatric care demonstration project beginning July 1, 1989.
