- 1. Commission. The current Maine Science and Technology Board shall act as the commission until the members of the Maine Science and Technology Commission 8 9 10 11 have been appointed and qualified.
- Personnel; property; and equipment. All funds, personnel, property and equipment of the Maine 12 13 Science and Technology Board shall be transferred to the Maine Science and Technology Commission. No 14 15 employee's pay will be adversely affected due to this 16 17 reorganization.
- 3. 18 Funds transferred. Notwithstanding 19 Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, sections 1585 and 20 1586, all accrued expenditures, assets, liabilities, balances, appropriations or allocations, transfers, 21 22 revenues or other available funds of the Maine Science 23 and Technology Board are transferred to the Maine 24 Science and Technology Commission.
- 4. Contracts and agreements. All contracts and agreements currently in effect with the Maine Science and Technology Board shall remain in effect under the 25 26 27 28 Maine Science and Technology Commission until 29 rescinded, terminated or modified.
- 5. Rules and procedures. All rules and procedures of the Maine Science and Technology Board 30 31 32 shall remain in effect and applicable to the Maine 33 Science and Technology Commission unless expressly 34 repealed or modified.
- Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect on 35 36 37 July 1, 1988.
