SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A "
to S.P. 846, L.D. 2202, Bill, "AN ACT to Strengthen
the Site Location of Development Law."

Amend the amendment in section 7 in subsection 5
by striking out all of paragraph C and inserting in
its place the following:

'C. Lots of 40 or more acres but not more than
500 acres shall not be counted as lots except
where:

(1) The proposed subdivision is located
wholly or partly within the shoreland area as
defined in Title 38, section 435;

C-1 Lots of more than 500 acres in size shall not
be counted as lots;'

Further amend the amendment in section 7 in
subsection 5 in paragraph E in subparagraph (1) in the
first line (page 5, line 23 in amendment) by striking
out the underlined words "abutting lots to an" and
inserting in their place the following: 'lots to an
abutting'
