COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1624, L.D. 2219,

8

Bill, "AN ACT to Permit the Department of

9

Transportation to Exempt Certain Railroad Crossings

10

from Requirements to Stop."

11

Amend the bill in paragraph C, in the 3rd line

12

before the statement of fact (page 2, line 11 in L.D.)

13

by inserting after the following: "expedient or

14

necessary." the following: 'For any exempt crossing

15

that does not have automatic warning devices, the

16

engineer shall stop the train prior to entering the

17

crossing, and a member of the train crew shall stop

18

all motor vehicle traffic prior to flagging the train

19

through the crossing. For an exempt crossing with

20

automatic warning devices, the engineer shall stop the

21

train prior to entering the crossing and determine

22

that all motor vehicle traffic has come to a stop

23

prior to proceeding.'

24

Further amend the bill by inserting before the

25

statement of fact the following:

26

'FISCAL NOTE

27

It is anticipated that all costs associated with

28

the posting of signs, conducting hearings and other

29

related expenses would be absorbed by the Department

30

of Transportation using existing resources.'
