 Committee on Staff Salary Parity and Nonresidential
 Services in Sheltered Group Homes for Girls.

5 The committee shall consist of 5 1. Members. members appointed as follows: One Senator to be appointed by the President of the Senate, one member of the House of Representatives to be appointed by the 6 7 8 9 Speaker of the House, one member representing the 10 private sector with direct experience in administering a sheltered group home for girls in Maine, one member 11 representing the Department of Human Services, and one 12 public member. The private sector provider and public member shall be appointed jointly by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House. All members 13 14 15 of the committee, except for the representative from the Department of Human Services, are entitled to receive expenses for days of attendance at committee 16 17 18 meetings, the same as board meetings, as defined in 19 20 the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 12002-A.

2. Duties. The committee annually shall review
 22 wage and benefit parity in sheltered group homes for
 23 girls.

3. Report. The committee annually shall submit
its findings and recommendations and any legislation
to the President of the Senate, the Speaker of the
House, the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations
and Financial Affairs and the Joint Standing Committee
on Human Resources.

STATEMENT OF FACT

19 This bill implements an updated salary structure for St. Andre's Group Homes. Two recent salary studies compared the agency's salary scale with 20 21 22 similar child welfare organizations, both public and private, on a regional level. This study found that the agency's salary levels are 24% to 36% below comparable pay scales. The bill allows for a studied 23 24 25 26 approach to this problem on an annualized basis. The bill also allows for the development of nonresidential services to better deal with the issue of pregnancy. 27 28
