The county administrator or, in the absence of a county administrator, the county commissioners shall appoint a treasurer and determine the treasurer's compensation and work schedule. The treasurer shall be responsible to the county administrator or, in the absence, administrator's the commissioners for all duties herein delineated. treasurer shall be chosen without reference to party affiliation and soley on the grounds of qualifications in matters of business administration and finance. The treasurer may be removed or suspended by the county commissioners only for cause. Any such action shall be in accordance with the procedure for removing or suspending a town manager under section 2313. Cause for dismissal, suspension or disciplinary action shall be a just, reasonable, appropriate and substantial reason for the action taken that relates to or affects the ability, performance of duties, authority or actions of the employee or the public's rights or interests.
