COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "^A" to H.P. 1636, L.D. 2235,
Bill, "AN ACT to Revise the Charter Commission Law."

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 by striking out all of paragraph B (page 2, lines 23 to 28 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'B. Appointive Only 2 appointive members need not be residents of the municipality, but only one may be a municipal officer officers. Appointments shall be made in accordance with municipal custom or bylaws and shall be made by the municipal officers within 30 days after the adoption of the charter commission.'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 2 in the 2nd paragraph in the 4th line (page 3, line 4 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "or municipal employee"

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment alters language so that 2 appointive members may be municipal officers instead
