COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1638, L.D. 2237,
Bill, "AN ACT to Appropriate Funds for Replacement of
Real Estate Tax Validation Machines in County
Registries of Deeds."

Amend the bill in the appropriation by striking
out the 4th line (page 2, line 4 in L.D.) and
inserting in its place the following:

'Capital Expeditures \$54,000'

Further amend the Bill in the appropriation by
striking out all of the last 5 lines (page 2, lines 5
to 9 in L.D.) and inserting in their place the
following: 'Provides funds for purchase of 18
electronic cash accounting machines and 2-year service
contracts on them. The machines shall remain the
property of the Bureau of Taxation. Subsequent
service and replacement obligations shall remain with
the Bureau of Taxation. A primary function of these
machines is to validate the tax payment on
declarations of value as required pursuant to the Maine
Revised Statutes, Title 36, section 4641-B.'
