7 SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 861, L.D. 2249,  
8 Bill, "AN ACT to Study Alternative Dispute Resolution  
9 in the Superior Court."

10 Amend the Bill in section 2 in the last line (page  
11 2, line 14 in L.D.) by striking out the figure  
12 "\$27,500" and inserting in its place the following:  
13 '\$40,500'

14 Further amend the Bill by inserting at the end  
15 before the statement of fact the following:

16 'FISCAL NOTE

17 This bill requires a General Fund appropriation in  
18 fiscal year 1989 of \$40,500. Funds will enable the  
19 Judicial Council to hire a consultant to design and  
20 implement the pilot program, provide for travel and  
21 other miscellaneous expenses.

22 Increases in General Fund revenues from fees  
23 generated by the program are estimated at \$20,000 in  
24 fiscal year 1989.'
