7 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 864, L.D. 2252, 8 Bill, "AN ACT to Correct Inconsistencies in the 9 Publication of Legal Notices."

10 Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 11 and inserting in its place the following:

12 'Sec. 1. 1 MRSA \$601, as amended by PL 1967, c. 13 428, 51, is repealed and the following enacted in its 14 place:

# 15 §601. Publication of legal notices and advertising

To be gualified as a medium for the publication of 16 17 legal notices, legal advertising and other matter required by law to be published in a newspaper, a 18 19 newspaper, unless otherwise ordered by the court in the proceedings, must be published and printed in 20 21 whole or in part in this State; must be printed in the English language; and must be entered as 2nd class postal matter in the United States mails at a post 22 23 24 office in this State. Any legal notice, legal advertising or other matter required by law to be published in a newspaper shall appear in all editions 25 26 27 of that newspaper.

### STATEMENT OF FACT

2 This amendment ensures that a newspaper with 2nd class mail privileges will qualify for legal notices 3 if its 2nd class mail permit is at a post office other 4 than the location where it is printed. Many weekly 5 newspapers are not printed where they have editorial 6 offices. The amendment also adds a requirement that legal notices appear in all editions of a paper to ensure that readers are not omitted by not subscribing 7 8 9 to the edition carrying the notices. 10
