SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 865, L.D. 2254,
8 Bill, "AN ACT Pertaining to Fire Permit Enforcement."

Amend the Bill by inserting after the enacting
10 clause the following:

11

'Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §9321, sub-§5-A is enacted to
12 read:

13

5-A. Notification. Any person authorized by this
14 subchapter to issue permits for open burning who
15 issues a permit for out-of-door burning within a
16 municipality shall notify the town forest fire warden
17 or fire chief of that municipality that the permit has
18 been issued. This notification requirement does not
19 apply to a town forest fire warden or deputy town
20 forest fire warden designated for a particular
21 municipality who issues a permit for out-of-door
22 burning within that municipality.'

Further amend the Bill by inserting at the
24 beginning of the first line after the enacting clause
25 (page 1, line 6 in L.D.) the following: 'Sec. 2.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment requires the person who issues an
28 outdoor burning permit for a fire within a

1 municipality to notify the fire chief or forest fire
2 warden designated for that municipality that a permit
3 has been issued. Because the purpose of this change
4 is to make sure someone in the town is notified that a
5 permit has been issued, if the town forest fire warden
6 or deputy town forest fire warden who issues the
7 permit is designated to serve that municipality, that
8 designated warden or deputy warden is not required to
9 notify anyone else.
