14 15	Whereas, a critical shortage of landfill space exists; and
16 17 18	Whereas, landspreading represents a viable option for some forms of sludge which are currently landfilled; and
19 20 21	Whereas, certain operational, health and environmental concerns must be resolved to achieve a successful landspreading program; and
22 23 24 25 25 25 27	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'

In view of the emergency 11 12 cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when 13 approved.'

15 The purpose of this amendment is to add an 16 emergency preamble, to eliminate a technical error, to 17 explicitly provide that the research foundation is 18 covered by the Maine Tort Claims Act and to add an 19 emergency clause.
