## 6 STATEMENT OF FACT

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14 15 16 This amendment clarifies that liftable axles will not be permitted for vehicles being operated under the provisions of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 29, section 1652, subsection 1, paragraph F, if the vehicle is manufactured after 1989. This amendment also permits vehicles carrying both general commodities and special commodities to do so by paying the general commodity permit fee alone. The amendment also adds a provision for a short-term, 3-month permit for general commodities.
