HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 869, L.D. 2264, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to 6-Axle Vehicles Carrying General
Commodities."

Amend the bill in section 1, in paragraph F,
subparagraph (7) in the last line (page 3, line 20 in
L.D.) by striking out the underlined words and
punctuation "function; and" and inserting in their
place the following: 'function.'

Further amend the bill in section 1, in paragraph
F, subparagraph (7) by inserting at the end the
following:

'All revenue generated by the permit fee
authorized under this subparagraph shall be
expended towards the enforcement of truck
weight regulations; and'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end
before the statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 3. Allocation. The following funds are
allocated from the Highway Fund to carry out the
purposes of this Act.

22 This bill will result in an increase in revenue to

26 general commodity permits.'

27 STATEMENT OF FACT

28 This amendment provides that the \$150,000 in
29 anticipated revenue to the Highway Fund from general
30 commodity permits shall be expended towards the
31 enforcement of truck weight regulations.
