Amend the resolve by striking out all of the 5th

paragraph after the title (page 2, lines 12 to 35 in

resolve) and inserting in its place the following:

'Commission established. Resolved: That the

Commission to Review the Laws Relating to Registered

Maine Guides be reconstituted with 13 members. Five

16

members of the House of Representatives, appointed by

the Speaker of the House, shall be members of the

commission as follows: Three members representing the

Joint Standing Committee on Fisheries and Wildlife;

one member representing the Joint Standing Committee

on Taxation; and one member representing the Joint

22

Standing Committee on Business Legislation. Two

23

Senators appointed by the President of the Senate

shall be members of the commission as follows: One

member representing the Joint Standing Committee on

Fisheries and Wildlife; and one member representing

the Joint Standing Committee on Taxation or the Joint

Standing Committee on Business Legislation. Six

29

nonlegislative members, appointed by the Governor

within 10 days of the effective date of this resolve,

shall be part of this commission as follows: Two

representatives of a professional guiding association;

one licensed Maine guide not affiliated with a

1 professional guiding association; one representative  
2 of a sportsmen's group; one representative of a  
3 trapper's association; and one representative of a  
4 sporting camp association. The Commissioner of Inland

6 member.'


7 Further amend the resolve in the 7th paragraph
