Amend the bill in section 1, in subsection 1, in  
the 6th line (page 2, line 5 in L.D.) by striking out  
the following: "Transportation" and inserting in its  
place the following: '~~Transportacion~~ Marine  
Resources'

Further amend the bill in section 1, in subsection  
3 by striking out all of the last underlined sentence  
(page 2, lines 18 and 19 in L.D.)

Further amend the bill in section 6, in that part  
designated "§5251." in subsection 3, by striking out  
all of the last underlined sentence (page 4, lines 36  
to 38 in L.D.)

Further amend the bill by inserting before the  
statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 8. Appropriation. The following funds  
are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out  
the purposes of this Act.

21 Statement of Fact

22 The purpose of this amendment is to delete  
 23 provisions which require a specific geographic  
 24 distribution on the Land for Maine's Future Board.  
 25 The amendment also replaces the Commissioner of  
 26 Transportation on the same board with the Commissioner  
 27 of Marine Resources. Finally, the amendment adds an  
 28 appropriation to supply staff support for the new  
 29 Maine Advisory Commission on Outdoor Recreation and to  
 30 provide for the per diem and expenses of the new  
 31 public members on the Land for Maine's Future Board.
