HOUSE AMENDMENT "*B*" to SENATE AMENDMENT "B " to
S.P. 889, L.D. 2301, Bill, "AN ACT to Enhance Outdoor
Recreation Opportunities."

Amend the amendment by striking out everything
after the title and inserting in its place the
following:

'Amend the bill by striking out all of section 7
and inserting in its place the following:

Sec. 7. 14 MRSA §159-A, sub-§6, as enacted by
1985, c. 762, §25, is repealed and the following
enacted in its place:

6. Costs and fees. In an action for personal
injury or property damage, the court shall order the
opposing party to pay any direct legal costs,
including reasonable attorneys' fees, to an owner,
lessee or occupant of premises:

A. Who is found not to be liable for injury or
damage to a person or property pursuant to this
section; or

B. Who is found by the court:

(1) To have been frivolously sued for injury
