12 13 14 15	The \$100,000 appropriated to the Department of Labor also appears in the proposed supplemental budget bill, Legislative Document 2156, under the Department of Human Services, Health Occupational Training.
16 17 18 19 20 21	It should also be noted that the bill requires hospitals participating in the training program to "bear those occupational training costs not covered by the Department of Labor." These amounts would also be added to the hospital's financial requirements by the Maine Health Care Finance Commission and would further increase hospital costs to all payors.'
