'4. Collective bargaining. It is not the intent  
of the Legislature in this section to limit or  
restrict the rights of state employees to bargain  
collectively as provided in Title 26. Nothing in this  
section may invalidate or supersede the provisions of  
a collective bargaining agreement between an employee  
organization and the State.'
