SENATE AMENDMENT " B " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 1687, L.D. 2316, Bill, "AN ACT to Consolidate State Land Use Statutes into the Natural Resources Protection Act."

Amend the amendment in section 2 by adding at the end the following:

'§480-S. Fee for significant wildlife habitat review

The department shall establish procedures to charge applicants for costs incurred in reviewing license and permit applications regarding significant wildlife habitats in the same manner as provided for other fees in section 352. The maximum fees are \$150 for processing and \$50 for a license. All fees shall be credited to the Maine Environmental Protection Fund established in section 351.'

Further amend the amendment by adding at the end before the statement of fact the following:

2 It is estimated that the new fee for review of
3 significant wildlife habitat will result in
4 approximately \$55,000 in revenues which will cover the
5 cost of the allocations provided by the bill from the
6 Maine Environmental Protection Fund.'


7 STATEMENT OF FACT

8 This amendment provides for a fee for review of
9 significant wildlife habitat by the Department of
10 Environmental Protection and provides for an
11 allocation to cover the costs of that review. It
12 includes an appropriation to the Maine Land Use
13 Regulation Commission to cover the costs of review of
14 forestry practices outside of Maine Land Use
15 Regulation Commission jurisdiction. It also includes
16 a fiscal note.
