**An Act to Clarify the Reporting Mechanism of the  
Student Assessment Program.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
follows:

Sec. 1.    20-A MRSA §6204, sub-§1, ¶A is enacted  
to read:

A.    When a report is made under this subsection  
for purposes of comparative analysis, the  
reporting mechanisms and the categories reported  
shall be uniform for each school.

1       Sec. 2.    20-A M RSA §6204, sub-§2, ¶A is enacted  
2 to read:

3       A. Every profile provided under this subsection  
4       shall use reporting mechanisms and categories  
5       which are uniform for each school.
