'2. Traffic movement. The developer has made adequate provision for traffic movement of all types into, out of or within the development area. The 12 13 14 15 board shall consider traffic movement both on-site and 16 off-site. Before issuing a permit, the board shall 17 determine that any traffic increase attributable to development will not result 18 the proposed in unreasonable congestion or unsafe conditions on a road 19 20 in the vicinity of the proposed development;

21 Further amend the Bill by striking out all of 22 section 2 and inserting in its place the following:

23 'Sec. 2. Report; rules. The board shall adopt 24 rules governing the traffic criteria of the Site Location of Development Law by January 15, 1989. The Commissioner of Environmental Protection shall submit 25 The 26 27 the rules to the joint standing committee of the 28 Legislature having jurisdiction over natural resources 29 for review by January 15, 1989. At the time of 30 the commissioner shall report to the submission, committee on efforts to revise the traffic criteria of 31 32 the Site Location of Development Law.'
