1 AN ACT Relating to Employment of Minors.
2

3 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
4 follows:

5 26 MRSA §773, 2nd paragraph is amended to read:

6 The provisions of this section pertaining to
7 manufacturing establishments shall not apply to minors
8 under 16 years of age who are employed in retail

1 establishments where any frozen dairy product or
2 frozen dairy product mix, such as candy, custard,
3 yogurt, frozen cake or pie decorated with or
4 containing other than a dairy product, or related food
5 product is manufactured on the premises, regardless
6 of trade name or brand or coined name.

7 STATEMENT OF FACT

8 This bill amends the law prohibiting employment of
9 minors in manufacturing concerns to further specify
10 the types or kinds of exemptions allowed.
