'§1496. Automated telephone solicitation prohibited;
exceptions; penalties

1. Prohibition. Except as provided in subsection
2, no person may without a live operator use an
automated telephone system or device for the selection
and dialing of telephone numbers to play recorded
messages for purposes of:

A. Offering any goods or services for sale;

B. Conveying information on goods or services in
soliciting sales or purchases;

C. Soliciting information; or

D. Gathering data and statistics.
