## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-EIGHT

AN ACT to Permit Fly-Fishing Only on a 2 Portion of the St. Croix River.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

12 MRSA §7553-A is enacted to read:

§7553-A. Fly-fishing on the St. Croix River

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1 2 3	Fly-fishing only is permitted on that part of the St. Croix River from the Milltown Dam in Calais to 2,600 feet downstream from that dam.
4	STATEMENT OF FACT
5 6 7 8 9	Currently, spin casting fishermen are fishing illegally for Atlantic salmon on the St. Croix River with artificial lures. This bill addresses that problem by providing for fly-fishing only on the St. Croix River for 2,600 feet below the Milltown Dam in Calais.
