STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-EIGHT

RESOLVE, Authorizing a Working Capital Advance for the Seed Potato Board.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the Seed Potato Board, a unit within the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources,

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1 is currently experiencing a cash-flow problem; and

2 Whereas, the Seed Potato Board will be unable to 3 meet its payroll and other expenses without an advance 4 from the General Fund; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these 5 6 facts create an emergency within the meaning of the 7 Constitution of Maine and require the following 8 immediately necessary legislation as for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; 9 10 now, therefore, be it

11 Working capital advance authorized. Resolved: That the State Controller is authorized to advance to 12 13 of Agriculture, Food the Department and Rural Resources' 14 Seed Potato Board from the State's Unappropriated Surplus, \$175,000, during any state fiscal year if requested in writing by the Secretary 15 16 of the Seed Potato Board, These funds will be used to 17 provide cash necessary to meet current expenses of the Seed Potato Board and will be returned to the State's 18 19 20 Unappropriated Surplus before the close of the state 21 fiscal year in which the advance was made. The State 22 Controller will report to the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs within 30 days 23 24 of making any working capital advance for this purpose,

25 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency 26 cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect 27 when approved.

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FISCAL NOTE

29 This legislation authorizes the Seed Potato Board 30 receive a \$175,000 working capital advance, or to loan, from the General Fund in any state fiscal year. It also requires the Seed Potato Board to repay the 31 32 33 General Fund for the amount advanced before the end of 34 the state fiscal year in which the advance was made. 35 As a result, there will be no significant fiscal 36 impact on the General Fund.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The operation of the Seed Potato Board is such that it can experience a temporary lack of cash that precludes the payment of payroll and other operating costs.

This resolve authorizes a working capital advance from the General Fund to assist the board in overcoming its cash-flow problem and requires the board to return the advance to the General Fund prior to the close of the fiscal year in which the advance was made.

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
