15 STATEMENT OF FACT

- 16 This amendment makes the following changes:
- 17 1. The per diem rate paid to the Panel of 18 Mediators is corrected to be consistent with Public 19 Law 1987, chapter 468;
- 20 The per diem of the Board of Trustees of the Maine Vocational-Technical Institute System is established at the legislative per diem rate, consistent with a previously enacted law that was 21 22 23 inconsistent with another enacted law; 24
- 25 3. The Therapeutic Pharmaceutical Monitoring Panel has been moved to a more appropriate category 26 27 entitled General Government. The panel is not an 28 occupational or professional licensing board;
- 29 4. The Agricultural Promotion Committee is 30 restored;
- 31 5. The Medical Advisory Board, Licensing 32 Drivers, is authorized to receive expenses only;

- 1 6. References to the Maine Indian Tribal State 2 Commission have been removed in order to comply with 3 federal law;
- 7. The per diem of the Maine State Retirement System Board is changed to legislative per diem to reflect the intent of the bill as stated in the statement of fact; and
- 8 8. The composition of the ad-hoc advisory board on minimum wage for construction projects has been changed to reflect the current statutory requirements for membership.
