1 Further amend the bill in section 16 in that part  
2 designated "§1307-A." in the first paragraph in the  
3 3rd line from the end (page 33, line 22 in L.D.) by  
4 inserting after the following: "trades," the  
5 following: 'a person from labor engaged in the  
6 highway and heavy construction trades,'

7 Further amend the bill by adding after section 19  
8 the following:

9 'Sec. 20. PL 1987, c. 468, §4, is amended to  
10 read:

11 Sec. 4. Effective date. This Act shall take  
12 effect ~~January~~ July 1, 1988.'

13 Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections  
14 to read consecutively.

15 STATEMENT OF FACT

16 This amendment makes the following changes:

17 1. The per diem rate paid to the Panel of  
18 Mediators is corrected to be consistent with Public  
19 Law 1987, chapter 468;

20 2. The per diem of the Board of Trustees of the  
21 Maine Vocational-Technical Institute System is  
22 established at the legislative per diem rate,  
23 consistent with a previously enacted law that was  
24 inconsistent with another enacted law;

25 3. The Therapeutic Pharmaceutical Monitoring  
26 Panel has been moved to a more appropriate category  
27 entitled General Government. The panel is not an  
28 occupational or professional licensing board;

29 4. The Agricultural Promotion Committee is  
30 restored;

31 5. The Medical Advisory Board, Licensing of  
32 Drivers, is authorized to receive expenses only;

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1           6. References to the Maine Indian Tribal State  
2 Commission have been removed in order to comply with  
3 federal law;

4           7. The per diem of the Maine State Retirement  
5 System Board is changed to legislative per diem to  
6 reflect the intent of the bill as stated in the  
7 statement of fact; and

8           8. The composition of the ad-hoc advisory board  
9 on minimum wage for construction projects has been  
10 changed to reflect the current statutory requirements  
11 for membership.
