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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1713, L.D. 2352,
Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Waldoboro Sewer District
Charter."

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Amend the Bill in section 1, in the 2nd and 3rd
lines from the end (page 2, lines 20 and 21 in L.D.)
by striking out the following: "proper protective
regulations" and inserting in its place the following:
'supervision'

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Further amend the Bill by inserting before the
statement of fact the following:

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'Sec. 3. Referendum; effective date. This Act
shall be submitted to the legal voters of the
Waldoboro Sewer District at an election to be called
and held for the purpose by December 31, 1988. The
election shall be called by the municipal officers and
shall be held at the regular voting places. The
election shall be called, advertised and conducted
according to the law relating to municipal elections;
except that the board of registration shall not be
required to prepare nor the town clerks to post a new
list of voters, and for this purpose the board of
registration shall be in session on the 3 working days
next preceding the elections, the first and 2nd days
to be devoted to registration of voters and the last
day to enable the board to verify the corrections of
the lists and to complete and close their records

1 of the session. The town clerk shall reduce the
2 subject matter of this Act to the following question:

3 "Shall the debt limit of the Waldoboro Sewer
4 District be increased to \$1,000,000 and nomination
5 procedures for trustees be changed?"

6 This Act shall take effect for all purposes
7 immediately upon its acceptance by a majority of the
8 legal voters voting at the election, but only if the
9 total number of votes cast for and against its
10 acceptance exceeds 10% of the registered voters of the
11 district, but failure of approval shall not prevent
12 subsequent elections.

13 The results of the elections shall be declared by
14 the municipal officers of the town and due
15 certificates of the elections shall be filed by the
16 town clerk with the Secretary of State.'

17 STATEMENT OF FACT

18 This amendment clarifies terminology in the
19 nomination procedure and adds a referendum provision.
