AN ACT to Amend the Law for Rest Room Requirements for Bed and Breakfast Establishments.

STATEMENT OF FACT

21 Under rules promulgated by the State Liquor premises 22 Commission, all that are licensed for on-premises consumption of alcoholic beverages 23 must 24 have separate toilet facilities for both sexes. This 25 bill requires that bed and breakfast establishments that sell wine or beer to their guests need only have one rest room facility. The bill also provides that 26 27 bed and breakfast establishments must be licensed to 28 29 sell beer or wine to their guests:
