COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1724, L.D. 2367,
Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Charter of the Portland
Water District."

Amend the Bill in section 1, by striking out all
of the 3rd sentence and inserting in its place the
following:

'When there is a trustee to be elected to represent 2
or more municipalities and there is a mutually
coincident municipal election within those
municipalities in the month of May, the election of
the trustee shall be held on that same day. When
there is not a mutually coincident election in May
within those municipalities, then the election of the
trustee to represent that area shall be held
concurrently with the statewide primary in June.'

Further amend the Bill in section 1, in the 21st
line (page 3, line 3 in L.D.) by inserting after the
underlined word "election" the underlined words 'in
those municipalities'

Further amend the Bill in section 2 by striking
out all of lines 4 to 11 (page 3, lines 18 to 25 in
L.D.) and inserting in their place the following:

'Nomination papers shall be submitted to each
municipal clerk of the municipalities within that area

3 STATEMENT OF FACT

4 This amendment clarifies ambiguities in the voting
5 procedure in the original bill and removes language
6 changing the deadline for filing nomination papers.
