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1 Whereas, the Town of Cape Elizabeth conducts its 2 municipal election during the month of May; and

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Whereas, the statewide primary is conducted on the 2nd Tuesday in June, and if the date the district election is not changed, it will be necessary to conduct 3 elections in the Town of Cape Elizabeth within a 6-week period; and

Whereas, the trustee who represents the Town of Cape Elizabeth also represents the Town of Gorham and it would be inappropriate for the district election from the area to be coterminous with the municipal election of the Town of Cape Elizabeth; and

13 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the 14 15 Constitution of Maine and require the following 16 immediately necessary for legislation as 17 preservation of the public peace, health and safety; 18 now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

21 Sec. 1. P&SL 1907, c. 433, §18, 2nd ¶, as 22 amended by P&SL 1981, c. 10, §1, is repealed and the 23 following enacted in its place:

24 Trustees shall be elected for the term of 5 years 25 at elections to be specially called and held in each municipality on the 4th Tuesday of May of each year or as hereinafter described. When there is a trustee to 26 27 be elected by the voters of the Cities of Portland or 28 29 South Portland, or both, and when either city holding its own election of municipal officers in May, 30 the election of the trustee to represent each city 31 concurrently with the municipal 32 be held election, and the city and the district shall equally share the cost of that municipal election. When there 33 34 When there 35 elected to represent 2 or more a trustee to be 36 municipalities and there is not a mutually coincident election in May within those municipalities, then the election of the trustee to represent such area shall 37 38

30	The purpose of this bill is to amend the Portland
31	Water District's charter to allow the holding of
32	elections of the district's trustees with other
33	elections being held in the municipalities
34	constituting the district.

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
