§410-F. Marine Environmental Monitoring Program

The Department of Environmental Protection in
19 cooperation with the Department of Marine Resources
20 shall establish the Marine Environmental Monitoring
21 Program. The initial purpose of this program shall be
22 to design a monitoring program to examine the extent
23 and effect of industrial contaminants and pollutants
24 on marine and estuarine ecosystems and to determine
25 compliance with and attainment of water quality
26 standards under article 4-A. This study shall
27 include, but not be limited to:

28

1. Sources. The sources, fates and biological
29 availability of these contaminants;
