13 January 1, 1989, shall continue in effect until  
14 rescinded, amended or changed according to municipal  
15 ordinance, charter or state law.'

16 STATEMENT OF FACT

17 The purpose of this amendment is to add a General  
18 Fund appropriation. This appropriation is currently  
19 included in the Governor's supplemental budget,  
20 Legislative Document 2156.
