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7 HOUSE AMENDMENT " \mathcal{H} " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "C" to 8 H.P. 1744, L.D. 2390, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish the 9 Additional Support for People in Retraining and 10 Education Program."

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 12 5.

13 Further amend the amendment in section 7, in that 14 part designated " $\S 3781$." by striking out all of 15 subsection 1 and inserting in its place the following:

16 '1. Administration. The Additional Support for
People in Retraining and Education Program shall be
administered by the Department of Human Services in
cooperation with the Department of Labor; Department
of Educational and Cultural Services; and other state
agencies having responsibilities relating to the goals
of this program.'

Further amend the amendment in section 7, in that part designated "<u>§3782.</u>" by striking out all of subsection 2 and inserting in its place the following:

1	A. The Department of Human Services is
2	responsible for providing case management services
3	to all Additional Support for People in Retraining
4	and Education Program participants, including the
5	following responsibilities: Assessment of the
6	registrants' training needs and occupational
7	preferences; development of the registrants'
8	employability plans, including their occupational
9	goals; provision of prevocational training either
10	by its own staff or through other appropriate
11	agencies; referral to appropriate educational and
12	training programs; monitoring and evaluating
13	registrants' progress in these programs; provision
14	of support services; and referral of individuals
15	to appropriate job placements. The registrants'
16	employability development plans shall be
17	determined in consultation with the department's
18	case manager.

19	B. The Department of Labor is responsible for
20	providing assistance when necessary in the
21	identification of training needs; providing
22	current labor market information; developing
23	employment opportunities for Additional Support
24	for People in Retraining and Education Program
25	participants; the provision of skills training to
26	individuals referred by the Department of Human
27	Services and job placements.'

29 The purpose of this amendment is to maintain the 30 current administration of the Welfare, Education and 31 Employment Training Program as part of ASPIRE 32 throughout the State.
