7 SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "C"
8 to H.P. 1744, L.D. 2390, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish
9 the Additional Support for People in Retraining and
10 Education Program."

11 Amend the amendment by striking out all of section
12 5.

13 Further amend the amendment in section 7, in that
14 part designated "§3781." by striking out all of
15 subsection 1 and inserting in its place the following:

16 '1. Administration. The Additional Support for
17 People in Retraining and Education Program shall be
18 administered by the Department of Human Services in
19 cooperation with the Department of Labor; Department
20 of Educational and Cultural Services; and other state
21 agencies having responsibilities relating to the goals
22 of this program.'

23 Further amend the amendment in section 7, in that
24 part designated "§3782." by striking out all of
25 subsection 2 and inserting in its place the following:

26 '2. Responsibilities. The program shall be
27 coordinated by the Department of Human Services in
28 consultation with and utilizing the resources of the
29 Department of Labor.

SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "C" to
H.P. 1744, L.D. 2390

1 A. The Department of Human Services is responsible
2 for providing case management services to all
3 Additional Support for People in Retraining and
4 Education Program participants, including the
5 following responsibilities: Assessment of the
6 registrants' training needs and occupational
7 preferences; development of the registrants'
8 employability plans, including their occupational
9 goals; provision of prevocational training either by
10 its own staff or through other appropriate agencies;
11 referral to appropriate educational and training
12 programs; monitoring and evaluating registrants'
13 progress in these programs; provision of support
14 services; and referral of individuals to appropriate
15 job placements. The registrants' employability
16 development plans shall be determined in consultation
17 with the department's case manager.

18 B. The Department of Labor is responsible for
19 providing assistance when necessary in the
20 identification of training needs; providing
21 current labor market information; developing
22 employment opportunities for Additional Support
23 for People in Retraining and Education Program
24 participants; the provision of skills training to
25 individuals referred by the Department of Human
26 Services and job placements.


27 3. Demonstration project. The department shall
28 contract with the Department of Labor to establish and
29 operate the Additional Support for People in
30 Retraining and Education Program in Franklin County as
31 a demonstration project.'
