COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1745, L.D. 2391,
Bill, "AN ACT to Extend the Uses of the Potato
Marketing Improvement Fund."

Amend the Bill in section 2 in that part
designated "§975." by striking out all of subsection 3
and inserting in its place the following:

'3. Use and disposal of cull potatoes. To
conduct a research program to explore and establish
productive uses of cull potatoes, to conduct
feasibility studies appropriate to such uses and to
conduct research pertaining to the safe and effective
disposal of culls not used for productive purposes.'

Further amend the Bill by inserting at the end
before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Sec. 3. Allocation. There is allocated from
the Potato Marketing Improvement Fund the sum of
\$300,000 to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Sec. 4. Sunset. This Act is repealed April 15,
1991.'

This amendment changes the use of grant money to deal with potato culls from a grant related to a specific use to funding a program for determining a use. It also adds a 1991 sunset provision to the bill and an allocation section to allocate the grant funds from the Potato Marketing Improvement Fund.
