8 SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A "
9 to S.P. 916, L.D. 2392, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for
10 the Safety of Health Care Workers Involved with the
11 Care and Treatment of AIDS Patients and Clarify the
12 Ability of Hospitals to Recover Increased Costs
13 Resulting from the Adoption of Recommended Treatment
14 Protocols."

14 Amend the amendment in section 4 in subsection 2
15 in the 6th and 7th lines (page 4, lines 26 and 27 in
16 amendment) by striking out the following: "Pretest and
17 post-test counseling must be provided by the person or
18 organization requesting the test." and inserting in
19 its place the following: 'Any person or organization
20 requesting the test must be responsible for offering
21 the person being tested pretest and post-test
22 counseling. If the offer is accepted, the insurer
23 shall reimburse the applicant for the cost of
24 counseling as defined in section 19204-A, subsections
25 1 and 2. In no event may an insurer reimbursing the
26 proposed insured be liable for any outcomes resulting
27 from the consultation.'

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This amendment defines the responsibilities of insurers with respect to pretest and post-test counseling for HIV. The amendment states that insurers will offer and pay for counseling, as defined in the committee amendment, but limits liability for counseling results.
