SENATE AMENDMENT " B " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 1748, L.D. 2397, Bill, "AN ACT to Require Licensure of Certain Railroad Personnel."

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the emergency clause (page 9, lines 26 to 30 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved, except that the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 32, section 4148, subsections 1 and 2, shall take effect on December 15, 1988.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies that the licensing requirement does not take effect until December 15, 1988.
