# COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1752, L.D. 2401

- Commission concerning the sale, merger, abandonment or embargo of any railroad line in this State shall concurrently file a copy of the petition or proposal with the Department of Transportation. Any person, corporation or other entity which proposes to acquire or construct an additional railroad line in this State or provide rail transportation over or by means of an extended or additional railroad line and which files a petition or proposal with the Interstate Commerce Commission to do so shall concurrently file a copy of the petition or proposal with the department.
- 3. Review; report. The department shall review any petition or proposal for major modification to the rail service in the State filed under subsection 2. Upon conclusion of its review the department shall report to the Governor and the Legislature, if the proposal has a major effect on rail service in the

## 19 FISCAL NOTE

It is anticipated that any costs relating to the issuance of reports and other related expenses would be absorbed by the Department of Transportation utilizing existing resources.'

#### 24 STATEMENT OF FACT

The amendment provides a mechanism by which the Maine Department of Transportation will be informed of proposed major modifications in rail service at the same time the petition or proposal to make this modification is filed with the Interstate Commerce Commission. The department will review the proposal and will report on it to the Governor and the Legislature, if it has a major effect on rail service in the State. The amendment deletes from the bill any requirement for a state permit, and it does not affect the jurisdiction of the Interstate Commerce Commission.
