1 **RESOLVE, to Authorize a Transfer of Surplus**
2 **Funds within the Franklin County Budget.**
3

4 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts and resolves
5 of the Legislature do not become effective until 90
6 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies;
7 and

8 Whereas, the sheriff's department of Franklin
9 County found it necessary to place law enforcement

1 officials in the Town of Jay; and

2 Whereas, these officials were required from June
3 to December to cover the labor strike at the
4 International Paper Company mill; and

5 Whereas, the expense of this action was not
6 expected or budgeted for and requires reimbursement at
7 the earliest possible time; and

8 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these
9 facts create an emergency within the meaning of the
10 Constitution of Maine and require the following
11 legislation as immediately necessary for the
12 preservation of the public peace, health and safety;
13 now, therefore, be it

14 **Transfer from surplus authorized in Franklin**
15 **County. Resolved:** That the county commissioners of
16 Franklin County are authorized to transfer from their
17 surplus account the sum of \$53,456 to the sheriff's
18 department account number 1075 to cover a deficit in
19 the 1987 Franklin County budget as a result of an
20 unexpected law enforcement obligation of the county.

21 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency
22 cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect
23 when approved.

24 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

25 The intent of this bill is reflected in the
26 emergency preamble.
