AN ACT to Extend a Sunset Provision in the
Civil Service Law.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the sunset provision which this legislation seeks to extend will take effect prior to the 90-day period; and

1 2 3 4	Whereas, the compensation system's negotiations are currently ongoing and continuation of the obligation to bargain on standards for job descriptions is essential to those negotiations; and
5 6 7 8 9	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,
11 12	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
13 14	5 MRSA §7061, sub-§7, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 541, is amended to read:
15 16	7. Sunset. Subsection 3 is repealed March 15, 1988 1990.
17 18 19	Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.

20 STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to extend by 2 years the sunset date in the law authorizing collective bargaining in compensation system negotiations on the issue of standards for the preparation and updating of written job classification specification.
