15	2. Membership. The commission shall consist of 9						
16 17	members who are active in and representative of the						
18	blueberry industry. Each member shall be aware of the opinions and needs of the member's constituency and						
19	communicate the results of commission activity to this						
20 21	constituency. Four members shall be blueberry growers who have no processing facilities; 4 members shall be						
22	blueberry processors who may or may not be growers and						
23	one member shall be the Commissioner of Agriculture,						
24 25	Food and Rural Resources or a designated departmental representative.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

6 This amendment adds a representative from the 7 Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources to 8 provide an uneven number of board members. The 9 amendment keeps the requirement of the original bill 10 that the commission membership be split equally 11 between processors and nonprocessors. Membership 12 currently is weighed in favor of processors. This 13 amendment requires replacement of a member who no 14 longer works in the section of the industry that he 15 was appointed to represent.
