COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1767, L.D. 2420,
Bill, "AN ACT to Make Changes in the Laws Concerning
Licensed Maine Guides and Related Laws."

Amend the bill in section 7 in that part
designated "\$7322.", in subsection 6, in the 5th line
(page 11, line 14 in L.D.) by striking out the
following "April 1, 1988" and inserting in its place
the following: "January 1, 1989"

Further amend the bill in section 13 in the 3rd
and 4th lines (page 14, lines 10 and 11 in L.D.) by
striking out the following: "April 1, 1988" and
inserting in its place the following: "January 1, 1989"

Further amend the bill by adding before the
emergency clause the following:

'Sec. 14. Effective date. The Maine Revised
Statutes, Title 12, section 7311, subsection 3, shall
take effect January 1, 1990.

Sec. 15. Allocation. The following funds are
allocated from Dedicated Revenues of the Department of
Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to carry out the
purposes of this Act.

10 Futher amend the bill by inserting before the
11 statement of fact the following:

12 'FISCAL NOTE

13 If enacted, the proposed legislation would:

14 1. Result in a maximum increase in dedicated
15 revenue to the Department of Inland Fisheries and
16 Wildlife of \$17,698 for fiscal year 1989. This
17 estimate is based on the anticipated additional
18 revenue received from the proposed requirement that a
19 guide purchase the license to guide as well as a
20 combination hunting and fishing license. Presently,
21 the license to guide includes the right to hunt and
22 fish;

23 2. Require an allocation to the Department of
24 Inland Fisheries and Wildlife in the amount of \$4,000
25 for fiscal year 1989. This allocation would provide
26 funds for the Advisory Board for the Licensing of
27 Guides to meet additional expenses from the proposed
28 \$50 per diem provision for 4 additional public
29 members; and

30 3. Result in a loss of revenue to the Department
31 of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife in the amount of
32 \$1,750 for fiscal year 1989. This loss of revenue
33 would be derived from the issuance of 70 complimentary
34 guide licenses to residents over 70 years of age.'

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1767, L.D. 2420

1 STATEMENT OF FACT

2 This amendment changes the dates for the
3 Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to
4 promulgate rules relating to this bill. It also
5 clarifies that new license fees will take effect after
6 the transition period.

7 An allocation section and fiscal note also are
8 added to reflect the costs and credits of the bill.
