COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1769, L.D. 2422,  
"RESOLVE, Authorizing the Bureau of Health to Conduct  
a Time-Trend Study of Leukemia Incidence in Maine."

Amend the resolve by striking out everything after  
the title and inserting in its place the following:

'Authorization of study. Resolved: That the  
Bureau of Health shall conduct a statewide time-trend  
study of the incidence of leukemia in the State. The  
bureau shall enlist the aid of health professionals,  
scientists and other qualified individuals. The  
bureau shall submit an interim report of its findings  
to the First Regular Session of the 114th Legislature  
by March 1, 1989, and a final report to the Second  
Regular Session of the 114th Legislature by January 1,  
1990; and be it further

Appropriation. Resolved: That the following  
funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry  
out the purposes of this resolve.
